SALS SHOES COLLECTION

Monday 16th - Tuesday 24th July

We are really pleased to be supporting the SALS Shoes 'Toe to Toe' project again this year. Our shoe collection last year was sent to Syria and Cambodia. SALS Shoes are a not-for-profit organisation set up in 2013, they collect pairs of children's shoes and distribute them in 26 countries including the UK. The charity collects all sorts of different types of shoes: flip flops, sandals, school shoes, slippers, trainers, winter boots, football boots etc. There are 300 million children in the world for whom walking with shoes is a rarity. This makes them extremely vulnerable to infection

by parasites, such as hookworm; while injuries to the feet and ankles can lead to ulcers and other conditions which are almost always left untreated. Without shoes, many children are not permitted to attend school.

Here at Leonard Stanley School we will be collecting pre-loved shoes (great for all those outgrown school shoes) throughout the week of the 16th - 24th July. The Eco-team will be going around all of the classrooms daily to collect your children's old shoes during the week.

On the last day of term your children can have the option of leaving their shoes on their tables and walking out of school 'shoeless' or bare footed to highlight the plight of children in poorer circumstances who do not have access to decent shoes. You will need to give permission for your child to do this. Permission letters will be sent home at the beginning of July.

Thanks to all of you who've paid your in-school swimming fees. Those that haven't will be sent a reminder letter at the beginning of next week.


