### SALS SHOES COLLECTION **Extended until Friday 6th September**

SALS Shoes are a not-for-profit organisation who collect pairs of children's shoes and distribute them in 26 countries including the UK. The charity collects flip flops, sandals, school shoes, slippers, trainers, winter boots, football boots etc. There are 300 million children in the world for whom walking with shoes is a rarity. Without shoes, many children are not permitted to attend school. We have extended our collection of **CLEAN** pre-loved shoes until Friday 6th September. Drop them into the collection box in the School Office Reception area DURING THE FIRST WEEK BACK. NOTE: Please attach a £1 donation to each pair of shoes you send into school. This is to cover the cost to SALS for transporting them to their final destination which could be 1000's of miles away. 


