




Children can come in non-uniform in exchange for tombola/raffle prizes.

So much achieved on Outdoor Learning Works Day

We would like to give massive thanks to the parents, staff, governors and children who gave up their Saturday to help achieve a big list of projects in our Outdoor Learning areas on Saturday 30th September. After successfully securing a Tesco Bags of Help grant of £1000 FOLSS set about securing the materials to build a performance stage area in our playing field. A group were tasked to build the stage with 90% of it built on the day and the remainder being completed on the 9th November. Another group were tasked with dismantling our long serving poly-tunnel which has now found a new home in a Forest School setting in Cirencester. This has paved the way for a new one to be erected during the spring of 2020. The ground has been levelled and surrounding overhanging branches lopped ready for the new foundations. A team weeded and newly bark chipped the Outdoor Classroom area and all vegetable beds were also weeded and produce collected. Our new Outdoor Learning area behind the FOLSS shed was also weeded and bark chippings scattered to help create a more usable space. The KS2 play trail which had come into disrepair after over 15 years of use was removed and it is hoped new equipment will replace this in the future. The various teams were powered by lots of donated cakes (thanks to those who donated) and refreshments.
